

Keep Your Eye On:

AC Power -

Monitor your AC shore power. If your shore power becomes disconnected or the breaker trips, it will alert you.

DC Power -

Monitor your DC power. Eliminate dead battery surprises. The power monitor can be used while onboard to alert you of a low battery while at anchor.

Temperature -


Temperature sensors alert you if the temperature approaches a freeze danger level.


Intrusion -


A pressure mat that can be placed in a disguised location of your choice will alert you when stepped on.

High Water -

The high water sensor consists of a float switch independent of any bilge pumps you may have. It will alert you to the presence of water at the level installed.

 According to the US Coast Guard, 80% of boats that sink or swamp do so while unattended.

 The cost of repairing a boat that sinks, is usually approximately 40% of its value, in addition to lost boating time.
